I'm privileged to undertake the pleasant duty of presenting the report of all the activities undertaken during the academic session 2025-26.

ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE

“Excellence in academics is the hallmark of any good institution”.

We achieved 100% result in classes 10 & 12, who appeared for the SSE and SSCE Examinations 2024-2025 respectively. In class 10, Abin Krishna NB (94.4%) got full A1 and was the topper. 16 students got above 90%, 30 students got above 80% and 26 students got above 70%. Vaiga Biju secured 100 in Malayalam and had become National topper. **In class 12, Rithvik Kozhissery Manoj, Krishna Priya K S and Vishnu Vidyanand had secured full A1. Rithvik Kozhissery Manoj (97%) was the topper in Science stream and Akash Sumod (94.4%) was the topper in Commerce stream. Rithvik Kozhissery Manoj secured 100 in physics, Akash Sumod secured 100 in Business Studies , Krishnapriya K S secured 100 in Chemistry and Computer Science, Abhirami P Ramesh secured 100 in Malayalam and had become National toppers. 2 students secured above 95%, 12 students secured above 90 %, 13 students secured above 80% and 24 students secured above 60 %.** The toppers and all winners were awarded and honored by the Chief Guest Mr Abhilash PA, Joint Commissioner, GST Dept, Thrissur and Vishnu PA Assistant Professor, SN college, BVM in the award Ceremony . Our School Manager Mr Ajith Prasad received trophy for 100% result of the school on the occasion of the program Abhinandaneeyam by Thanal charitable society, Valapad .

ACHIEVEMENTS:

- 145 students Participated in Thrissur Central Sahodya Kalotsav-2025 at Raju Davis International School, Mala in various individual and group items thereby exposing their talents beyond the school premises. Students secured prizes in 21 individual items and 5 group items holding 6th position in TCS schools. Most of the students secured A grade in their respective

items. Avirath had become Kalaprathibha under Category 3 securing prizes in Light music Malayalam, Classical music Karnatic, Recitation Malayalam, and group song.

25 students participated in CBSE State Kalotsav held at Pala, Labour India School. Our students secured second prize in Oppana and Third prize in Group dance under category 3. Vyga KI secured third prize in Digital painting under category 4. All others secured A grade.

Many other prizes were also received by students on this occasion.
- Ary Chethikatt and Narun Dev of class 12 have achieved a remarkable third place in ZeTalk hosted by TCS, and Zeta Academy held at Peace Public School, Mathilakam
- Our students secured first and second positions under category 1 at the Roboverse 2.0, interschool robotic competition held at Raju Davis International School.
- Mini Throw ball Girls and boys teams secured a third prize at Thrissur Jilla Championship.
- Nyle of class 6 has achieved the incredible feat of being selected for the Thrissur under 15 girls cricket team.
- Thrissur district athletic meet 2025-Nyle of class 6 excelled in the Under 12 girls shot put, while Bhaumik of class 3 secured third place in the under 10 boys shot put category.
- In connection with Sree Narayana Guru Jayanthi, students participated in inter school competitions @ SNDP Natika and Kothakulam and received many prizes.
